- * They are received without the relevant fee.
- * Incorrectly completed, including entering times faster than the upper cut times
- * Improved or falsified entry times.
- * Received after the closing date of 2nd November 2012.

PLEASE NOTE THERE WILL BE NO CARDS FOR THIS COMPETITION.

Ages are at 9th December 2012

As this is a Junior Development Level 4 meet only swimmers who have NOT achieved a Swim Wales Age Group Qualifying Time are allowed to take part.

Consideration times and upper cut-off times are based on individual ages, but for the purpose of running the meet efficiently the following age groups will be used when swimming the events:

Girls 8, 9, 10/11, 12/13, 14/15 and over.

Boys 8, 9, 10, 11/12, 13/14, 15 and over.

ENTRY FEES

£4.00 per event, or £16 for all of the Pentathlon events

MARSHALLING

Swimmers must make themselves available for marshalling as soon as advised by the public address system.

OFFICIALS

Visiting clubs are requested to provide at least one qualified official per session, and their details (together with their qualification) should be forwarded with the entry information. Meals and refreshments will be provided.

MEDALS

Medals will be awarded for 1st – 3rd places in each individual age based on the combined scores obtained in the pentathlon event. Ages are not grouped for medal purposes. Swimmers who do not swim all 5 events are not eligible for a medal.

SPECTATORS

Admission Charges

* £6 for all day, an individual session is £2.

Programmes will also be available to purchase.

CAR PARKING

There is free car parking plus there are several overflow car parks.

REFRESHMENTS

There is a coffee shop on site. There are also vending machines, and the local Cricket Club is also available for food and refreshments.

CAMERA USE

The use of **all** photographic equipment is controlled at this Meet and everyone is reminded that such equipment should not be used without registration. Registration Forms can be obtained from the entry desk.

MOBILE PHONES

Mobile phones must not be used in the pool hall and changing rooms.

Promoters Conditions

1. The meet will be swum under the following rules and conditions:
FINA Technical Rules and Swim Wales Laws.
2. All entrants must be members of an Affiliated club, amateurs as defined by Swim Wales Laws and hold a valid Swim Wales/ASA membership number.
3. The promoters reserve the right to limit entry in the interests of safety and timely completion of the meet.
4. Over the top starts will, where necessary or appropriate, be used during this meet.
5. Entries should be submitted electronically using Hy-Tek Team Manager software. The events file for input into TM is available upon request from andrew.newportswim@orangehome.co.uk. In exceptional circumstances entries will be accepted using the standard form provided. No entries will be accepted without the correct full payment.
6. The entry fee is £4.00 per event, or £16 for any swimmer who enters all the events of the pentathlon, with a single cheque sent per club and made payable to "City of Newport Swimming Club". **All entries must also include a payment summary sheet, completed coach/chaperone accreditation forms where appropriate and an email address for return of confirmed entries and the timetable.**
7. Ages are not grouped for the purposes of entry times or medals, but the following age groups will be used to ensure an efficient use of lanes during the meet:
Girls – 8, 9, 10/11, 12/13, 14/15 and over
Boys – 8, 9, 10, 11/12, 13/14, 15 & over
As this is a level 4 meet, 8 and 9 year old boys and girls are also able to swim the pentathlon events, but over shorter distances.
8. Ages as at last day of the meet i.e. 9th December 2012.
9. For the meet there are upper cut off times and consideration times. Swimmers who have swum a time equal to or faster than the upper cut off time are not eligible to enter the event. All swimmers with entry times falling between the upper cut off time and the consideration time will be eligible to swim in that event provided the meet is not oversubscribed, with the faster times being given priority. Entries slower than the consideration time will not be considered, and refunds will not be issued so please check your times carefully. **All entry times must be converted to a short course pool.**
10. For 8 and 9 year old swimmers consideration times are not required and swimmers can enter with 'no time'. For 9 year old swimmers there is an upper cut off time as in note 9 above. There is no upper cut off time for 8 year old swimmers, however, they must **NOT** have achieved a Swim Wales Age Group or Youth Qualifying Time (this includes swimmers taking part from outside Wales).
11. No swimmer may enter events "Out of Age".

12. Closing date for entries is midnight Friday 2nd November 2012. Entries received after this date cannot be guaranteed consideration. Please note that there will be no cards for this competition.
13. All withdrawals must be notified to the Meet Office no later than 5pm the day before the competition.
14. All coach's/chaperone passes, to include a full set of results sheets and all programmes, are available at a cost of £10.00 per pass. All applications for this pass must include WASA/ASA number and CRB check details for verification and a passport sized photo. **Passes must be worn at all times when poolside or in the changing rooms.** The closing date for passes is the same as for entries, and passes will not be available on the day of the meet. Coaches/chaperone's without a valid pass will not be permitted poolside or allowed into the changing rooms.
15. Visiting clubs are requested to provide at least one qualified official per session, and their details (together with their qualification) should be forwarded with entry information. Meals and refreshments will be provided.
16. Marshalling will take place, and competitors must report promptly to this area.
17. All swimmers, officials, volunteers, spectators, and visitors are required, at all times, to abide by the rules set out in the Pool Operating Procedures and / or the Normal Operating Procedures & Emergency Action Plan for the facility hired for the meet.
18. Swimmers must have attained the standard of the Competitive Start Award in order to start from the blocks; (this is the responsibility of the club coach).
Swimmers who have not attained the standard of the Competitive Start Award must lower themselves over the side into the water, on the long whistle of the Referee before starting at an appropriate place.
19. Individual teams/coaches will be responsible for their own swimmers in all areas outside the pool including the changing rooms.
20. All valuables/clothing etc. left in the changing rooms will be entirely at the owner's risk.
21. Events will be swum in heats, slowest to fastest, with every heat being spearheaded. All events are Heat Declared Winner.
22. The fastest three in each pentathlon (for each individual age - not grouped) will receive medals. In order to be eligible for the pentathlon medals the swimmer must have swum in all 5 events.
23. For the purposes of scoring the pentathlon, swimmers who are disqualified from any event will be awarded the time of the slowest legal swim of their age plus an additional 5 seconds. These replacement times will only be used for scoring the pentathlon and will not be valid times for entries to future meets, and they will not be sent to the ASA rankings database.
24. When a competition involves children under the age of 18 years it is a mandatory meet license requirement that all persons (including competitors/officials/volunteers/spectators), wishing to engage in any kind of photographic activity including video, zoom, close range photography, irrespective of the nature of the device/equipment used for taking/recording such images must register their details with the event management in advance of taking any images.
This includes, but is not limited to:
Still cameras
Cine cameras
Video cameras
Camera/video enabled mobile phones
Camera enabled PDA's.

Proof of identity is required to register any photographic/video equipment.

25. DATA PROTECTION ACT 1998 – CITY OF NEWPORT SWIMMING CLUB uses a computer to record entries and results. By submitting entries and accepting entry to the meet, consent is thereby given (as required under the Data Protection Act 1998) to the holding of personal information in a computer/s. Personal data recorded, such as name, club, date of birth and times may be made public during or after the meet.
26. The first session will have a warm-up time of 8.00am and a start time of 9.00am. Warm up and start times for sessions 2 and 3 will be confirmed when all entries have been received and processed. Details will be returned with the confirmation of entries.
27. Acceptable Behaviour - Behavior becomes “unacceptable” when it is considered “Offensive” to others; this includes, but is not limited to, the following:

Theft, willful damage to property and / or equipment, acts of vandalism, abuse of alcohol and / or drugs, bullying, offensive language, aggressive / violent acts, threatening behavior, all breaches of safety practices, failure to comply with instructions / directions, actions that bring the sport of swimming into disrepute.
28. Jewellery - For safety and security reasons, the wearing of jewellery is not permitted while in the water during warm-ups / swim-downs and / or competition. This includes watches, necklaces, chains, bangles, wrist bands, ear-rings (except studs), and rings (except wedding bands).

Swim Wales will not be responsible for any jewellery brought to events and will not be liable if such jewellery is lost or damaged.
29. Seating – the first 4 rows of the spectator area will be reserved for swimmers in addition to the seating on the far side of the pool.
30. The promoters reserve the right to remove anyone for misconduct.
31. The promoters reserve the right to remove or amend any of the above conditions as required.

There are no consideration times for 8 and 9 year olds and these swimmers are allowed to enter with no times. If any swimmer has achieved a Swim Wales Age Group or Youth Qualifying Time then they are not eligible to swim in the relevant event.
